

Attention Motorists and Pedestrians:

Ongoing through mid-August, excavation is taking place for a Reclaimed Water utilities project along South Road. This work is scheduled to take place during overnight hours (7 p.m. through 9 a.m.) in phases, and two-way traffic will be maintained via flagmen during those hours. Steel plates will cover the excavation during daylight hours allowing for normal traffic patters with minor disruptions.

Due to the permanent staging fence which will run along the active excavation site beginning, some pedestrian detours will be implemented. During the upcoming phase of this project beginning as early as July 6th, an area directly in front of the Fetzer Gymnasium entrance will be closed, and pedestrians will need to cross at either the crosswalk at the Student Union / SRC or at the Old Bell Drive entrance. The Eastbound South Road bus stop in this area will be temporarily relocated just to the west (see map below).

Signs, barriers, and cones will notify motorists and pedestrians of detours on this site, and web postings will be updated to reflect the progress of this project.
