Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
<p>RV Parking:</p> <p>Where do I park an RV and how much does it cost?</p> <p>How early can I arrive?</p> <p>Are there RV hook-ups?</p> <p>How do I get to the game from the RV parking?</p>	<p>RV parking is free at the Friday Center Park and Ride Lot off of NC Highway 54. There is no public RV parking on campus. Parking in the Friday Center Park and Ride Lot is available to RV's beginning 5 p.m. on the Friday evening preceding football Saturdays until 5 p.m. the Sunday following home football game Saturdays.</p> <p>However, fans should note that while RV parking is allowed in the Friday Center Park and Ride Lot, there are no hook-ups and no public restrooms in the lot. The closest RV parking areas with hook-ups are located at Jordan Lake and the Eno River State Park. The following is a link to our RV page listing the local RV Parking Locations: http://www.dps.unc.edu/SpecEvent/campusaccess/rvparking/rvparking.cfm</p> <p>Fans parking at the Friday Center Park and Ride Lot can get to the game by riding the Chapel Hill Transit buses, beginning 3 hours prior to game time. The cost is \$5 per person roundtrip.</p> <p>Reservations are not required for individual RV's. However, groups are encouraged to notify the Department of Public Safety at least 72-hours in advance (919.962.3951 or http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm)</p> <p>All RV's are asked to limit the number of parking spaces used so we maximize space. Less than 7 spaces per RV is a good guideline. RV patrons are also asked to pick-up their trash before leaving the parking area, so we may continue to offer the lot as an alternative parking location for RV's.</p>
<p>Disability Parking</p> <p>Where do fans with disabilities park and how do they get to the stadium?</p>	<p>Disability parking is reserved in the Ambulatory Care Lot off Mason Farm Road (near Columbia Street). Wheelchair accessible vans and buses service our fans with disabilities and take them and their caretaker (if this applies) to the main north and south side gates.</p> <p>Shuttles are designated for each side of the stadium (north and south), so fans need to make sure they ride the correct shuttle to get to their destination. Stadium seating information is printed on the game tickets.</p>

<p>Disability Parking</p> <p>What is required for access to disability parking and shuttles?</p>	<p>Any vehicle displaying a disability plate, permit or placard will be given access to the reserved disability parking, if the driver also pays the \$10.00 parking fee.</p>
<p>Disability Parking</p> <p>Is it possible to arrange one-game disability parking for someone that has a temporary disability such as a broken leg, but no disability permit?</p>	<p>Yes, as long as the request is made at least 72-hours in advance. DPS cannot guarantee a parking permit for requests less than 72-hours in advance. Contact the Department of Public Safety at 962-3951 or http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm for special one-game parking permits for access to the disability parking lot.</p> <p>There will be a \$10.00 parking fee upon entry to the disability parking lot, but the permit from Public Safety will allow access to the lot with the \$10.00 entry payment.</p>
<p>Bus Parking</p> <p>Where do Charter buses park? How do I make arrangements and how much does it cost?</p>	<p>Charter buses park on Bowles Drive near the Dean E. Smith Center unless there is an event at the Smith Center that precludes that from happening. Parking on Bowles Drive is \$40 per bus. Arrangements can be made through the Department of Public Safety in advance or buses can take their chances and drive to Bowles Drive on game day. All non-reserved spaces are available on a first-come-first-serve basis.</p> <p>To make a reservation, complete the website request form at least 72 hours in advance of game day. DPS cannot guarantee a parking permit for requests less than 72-hours in advance and it is recommended that requests are made at least one-week in advance. The web request address is: http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm</p>
<p>Bus Parking</p> <p>Bowles Drive is too far from the stadium for some of the fans on the buses to walk. Is there a place the bus can drop-off before parking on Bowles Drive and then pick-up after the game?</p>	<p>Special arrangements need to be made for drop-off, if it is needed for some location other than Bowles Drive. Drop-off in other locations is discouraged, because doing so holds up traffic and causes traffic flow problems. In certain cases, arrangements can be made through the Department of Public Safety via the website at http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm</p> <p>DPS cannot guarantee arrangements can be made for requests less than 72-hours in advance.</p>

<p>Employee Parking</p> <p>I'm an employee and I plan on working on game day. Where do I park?</p>	<p>UNC and UNC Hospitals employees working on game day can park in a variety of locations including the Dogwood Deck on south campus and the Swain Lot on north campus. At the Dogwood Deck, show your employee ID upon exit and you will be allowed to exit for free. At the Swain Lot, a UNC One Card or regular employee permit will gain you access to the lot.</p>
<p>Picnicking / Tailgating On Campus</p> <p>Can I tailgate in the campus parking lots prior to game time?</p>	<p>Tailgating is allowed, but open flames and alcohol are prohibited.</p> <p>Use of more than one parking space per vehicle is also prohibited. Limiting the number of spaces used per vehicle allows more fans to park on campus and experience the game day atmosphere.</p> <p>Fans are expected to clean-up their trash and act respectfully, so tailgating can remain a game day tradition.</p> <p>An alternative to traditional tailgating is TAR HEEL TOWN. Tar Heel Town starts 2.5 hours prior to game time and includes: (1) The Old Well Walk with Coach Davis and the Team, (2) The Kick-off Show Live from Tar Heel Town, (3) Activities such as face painting, rock climbing and inflatables, (4) Visits by the Tar Heel Mascot, (5) Give-aways such as posters, trading cards, etc. (5) Parker's Barbecue and other food. Traffic Information

Due to the volume of vehicles in and around campus on home football game days, it is best to plan on arriving to campus early and best to follow suggested directions of travel.

Football patrons without football parking permits for campus are encouraged to carpool or use the Chapel Hill Transit Tar Heel Express Park and Ride Shuttles.

The volume of traffic on campus on game days and the various parking needs require that parking lots and streets are restricted and/or screened. As part of the game day parking and transportation operation, vehicles may be asked to travel in a direction other than the one most preferred. Patrons, students and/or employees may be restricted from entering certain lots or streets. Traffic control studies have been conducted and traffic patterns are set to best benefit the overall operational needs.

Please heed the signs and requests of the parking monitors and traffic control personnel, as they are here to make the operation run as smoothly as possible during a very busy and difficult event.

Traffic is typically heaviest 1.5 hours prior to game time. Please plan accordingly. A little patience and extra planning will make each person's event experience more pleasant.

The following roads are always restricted to special permits prior to games. Vehicles without the proper UNC 2009 Football Parking Permit are not allowed access (official emergency vehicles are an exception):

The following roads are restricted pre and post game:

- **Ridge Road is restricted at Manning Drive and only Valid Permits for the Ridge Road Area will be admitted**
- **Stadium Drive is one-way from South Road to Ridge Road**
- **South Road is restricted at Columbia Street, except for buses and specific game permits such as "ST-Stadium Drive" Permits, or "Tar Heel Town Undergrad/Wilson" Permits or "BT-Bell Tower" Permits.**

The following roads are restricted post game:

- **South Road is one-way east-bound from Columbia Street to Country Club beginning the 3rd quarter**
- **Stadium Drive is restricted to exiting traffic and special buses**
- **Ridge Road**
- **West Drive from Manning Drive to Mason Farm Road**

Helpful Hint: Public Parking is best accessed via US 15/501 to Columbia Street and Manning Drive. Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54. Likewise, patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to Columbia Street exit to Manning Drive, rather than entering campus along Raleigh Road or Manning Drive at US 15/501. Most of the public parking is positioned along the Columbia Street end of Manning Drive.

Tar Heel Express Shuttles

Get to Kenan Stadium the Easy Way: Ride the Tar Heel Express

On home football days, Chapel Hill Transit operates special shuttles from park and ride lots located throughout Chapel Hill and Carrboro. All Game Day "Tar Heel Express" buses drop-off and pick-up on campus along South Road in front of Carmichael Auditorium and Woolen Gym. Additionally, buses from two of the lots drop-off and pick-up at Franklin Street, Tar Heel Town and South Road.

This is a recommended and viable option to driving to campus in the traffic and looking for a legitimate public parking space. Public Parking on campus is limited!

Park and Ride Locations Include:

- Jones Ferry Road near University Lake
- Friday Center Park and Ride off NC 54
- University Mall next to Dillard's
- Southern Village off US 15 and US 501
- Administrative Office Building (AOB) and 725 Airport Road off MLK Boulevard

Service from the NC Highway 54 **Friday Center Park & Ride Lot** next to the Friday Center, from the parking lot next to **Dillard's at University Mall, from the "P Lot"** off Estes Drive / Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Historic Airport Road) and the **725 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard Lot** begins **3 hours prior to game time** so that fans may enjoy the festivities at Tar Heel Town, which typically is open to the public beginning 2.5 hours prior to game time until 1 hour prior to game time. The Friday Center and Dillard's Lot Tar Heel Express buses drop-off and pick-up on campus along South Road in front of Woolen Gym (near the stadium). The "P Lot" and "725" Tar Heel Express buses will drop-off at a to be determined Franklin Street location (probably Carolina Coffee Shop), Tar Heel Town (Old Well on Cameron Avenue) and on South Road. The "P Lot" and "725" Tar Heel Express buses will pick-up post game at South Road until traffic clears and for 3 hours post game from Franklin Street.

Service begins **1.5 hours before game time** from **Jones Ferry Road** off NC 54 West in Carrboro and the **Southern Village Park & Ride lot** located on 15-501 south of town. Tar Heel Express buses from these locations will drop-off and pick-up at South Road on the UNC campus.

One-way fare for Tar Heel Express service is \$3.00; Round-trip service is \$5.00. Return trips from South Road begin immediately after each event and continue for approximately 1/2 hour (more or less depending on the crowd at the shuttle stop).

More Tar Heel Express Information...

Enjoy Chapel Hill: Whether you like to come early, stay late or both, Downtown Chapel Hill and UNC are Proud to offer an easier way to make a day of Carolina Football. Back by popular demand, Tar Heel Express will operate shuttles from AOB and 725 Airport Road as part of "Touch Downtown." Buses will pick-up from at least one Franklin Street designated location beginning approximately 90 minutes after game time and make continuous trips to/from the "AOB Lot" and "725 Lot" until 3 hours post game. This service is designed to offer fans the ability to stay and enjoy Franklin Street post game, but still take advantage of Park and Ride services. **Coming early or staying after to enjoy Downtown Chapel Hill has never been easier. You'll find 81 restaurants, 68 retailers and a mile of family cultural attractions.**

General Public Parking

Certain lots are reserved for general public parking. The fee for regular public parking is **\$10.00** this season. **Exact change is appreciated** because it decreases traffic congestion by allowing quicker handling of the change and thus quicker parking. The general public is encouraged to park standard sized vehicles (not buses and RV's) in the following lots. No more than one space per vehicle is allowed:

The reserved public parking locations for the 2009 football season are:

- PD- Cardinal Deck (approximately 1,400 spaces)
- Manning Lot (approximately 500 spaces)
- Jackson Deck next to Dogwood Deck (400 spaces)
- General Administration (approximately 100 spaces); free shuttle provided

RV parking will be available at the **Friday Center Park and Ride Lot off of NC Highway 54 Lot**. **Travel to campus is available via the Tar Heel Express, which services this lot**. There is **NO PUBLIC RV PARKING** on campus this season. Reservations are encouraged for all games so enough space can be reserved to accommodate these special oversized vehicles. **RV parking is free in the Friday Center Park and Ride Lot**, but RV patrons using this lot are expected to keep the number of spaces occupied to a minimal (no more than 7) and to clean-up any trash generated prior to departure. To make a reservation, contact DPS at least 72-hours in advance by using the website at <http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm>. DPS cannot guarantee a parking permit for requests made less than 72-hours in advance. DPS recommends making requests at least one-week in advance.

Public bus parking is designated on Bowles Drive near the Dean E. Smith Center as space allows (and as long as there are no conflicting events scheduled for the Dean E. Smith Center). Should overcrowding occur or the space become necessary for a Dean E. Smith Center event, buses will be re-routed to the Friday Center Park and Ride Lot off of NC Highway 54. **Bus parking will be \$40 this season, unless buses are sent to the Friday Center Park and Ride (no charge at the Friday Center)**.

Disability Parking & Shuttles

Parking

Specific **parking** spaces are set aside for game day/night disability parking. Patrons with state (any state) disability permits or plates may park in these spaces at the general public parking fee, which is \$10.00 for this football season. Patrons without a state issued disability permit or plate may arrange for a special event disability-parking permit by contacting the **UNC Department of Public Safety** at least 72 hours in advance at **(919) 962-3951** or via our website using the request form at <http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm> .

Disability parking spaces for the 2009 Football Season have been set aside in the **Ambulatory Care Lot** off Mason Farm Road and Columbia Street. Back by popular demand, shuttle buses and vans chartered by the Department of Public Safety via an agreement with ***Carolina Livery*** will provide shuttle service to and from the stadium and South Road for Tar Heel Town again this year. Because there will be only one vendor (***Carolina Livery***) providing disability shuttles this season, patrons are encouraged to check the shuttle labels before boarding to ensure they are boarding the desired "north side" or "south side" shuttle.

Shuttles

Shuttle Service (vans and mini-buses) to and from the stadium begin **3 hours prior** to the game and operate until 10 minutes after kick-off. They resume service post game as the crowd and traffic allows. Response time post game will vary depending on construction traffic patterns and game traffic.

The pay parking fee covers some of the expense for these shuttles, but other revenue generated by the Department of Public Safety is used to pay for the remainder of the shuttle expenses. The shuttles are not sponsored by any state or federal money. ***Shuttle drivers are not allowed to accept gratuities*** as they are paid to operate the shuttles and provide professional service to our valued event patrons with disabilities.

Due to the limited resources and the desire to provide the most efficient service possible to our patrons with disabilities, the shuttles may be restricted to our patrons with disabilities and 1 "caretaker" in the cases where patrons need additional assistance. If the shuttles are abused by non-disabled patrons and this adversely affects the service to our patrons with disabilities and their caretakers, a ticket collection process will be put into effect whereby disabled patrons and their "1 caretaker" are given tickets to ride the shuttles and only shuttle ticket holders will be provided transportation.

Employee Parking

Approximately 1,200 employee parking spaces are reserved for working employees with valid parking permits, UNC Hospitals credentials or UNC 2009 Special Event Employee parking permits. Departments with temporary or permanent employees without weekday employee permits, but who will be reporting to work on game days, may contact the UNC Department of Public Safety via our website request from at

<http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm> for special event parking permits that will be honored in game day employee lots. **However, valid PID numbers may be required prior to issuance of employee game day work permits.**

The following lots are reserved specifically for employees reporting directly to work and not attending the football game:

- Swain Lot
- Peabody Lot
- Old East Lot
- Emerson Drive
- Davis Drive
- Caldwell and Steele (NG3 Permit Holders Only)
- Beard Lot (May be reserved for other special events coinciding with football)
- Dogwood Deck
- Craige Deck (Employee CD permit holders already parked on game day)
- CG Helipad Lot (CG permit holders only)
- Cardinal Deck (PD permit holders already parked on game day)
- Cobb Deck (ND permit holders only)

Student Parking

Parking in **Resident Student Lots** is reserved for Resident Students with valid Student Permits for those particular lots. During certain hours prior to home football games, monitors are positioned at the entrance to resident lots and will not allow anyone without a valid lot permit to park in the resident lots. Overcrowding from Friday night parking often occurs in the Hinton James Lot (M Lot), Ehringhaus Lot (K Lot), and Morrison Dorm Lot (L Lot), thus "K, L or M" permits will be honored in the Manning Lot by the Dean E. Smith Center on Saturday, while vehicles outside of marked spaces within the "K, L and M lots" may be cited and/or towed for interference with traffic.

On Football weekends, students are HEAVILY ENCOURAGED NOT to bring vehicles to campus if they do not have a weekday parking permit.

Construction has limited parking for game day and too many additional vehicles on campus on game days may result in towing from more lots than in previous years. Possible alternative off campus parking locations for football Saturdays include the "P Lot" off Airport Road next to the Physical Plant, the Friday Center Lot off NC Highway 54 and the 725 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (Historical Airport Road) Lot next to the Sheps Building (across from Fosters Market and the Hunams).

Many **Commuting Student Lots and some combination Employee/Student Lots** are reserved for game operations and **NOT available** for student or employee parking on game days. Commuting Student Lots and Employee/Student Lots reserved for game day special event permits require the lots to be empty beginning 8 a.m. on game day. The following are examples of these type of lots:

- S10-Boshamer
- S4-Stadium Drive
- S10-Avery
- S3-Ridge Road
- S3-Navy Field
- S3-Knapp
- S3-Law Programs
- CD-Craige Deck (student permits are not valid)
- RD-Rams Head Deck
- N5-Park Place
- K-Lower Ehringhaus Lot (The upper lot is available)
- S12-Hibbard and Branson on the East side of Mason Farm Road are unavailable

There are some **Commuting Student Lots and Employee/Student Lots** reserved for game day use, but that do not require vehicles already parked to move from the lot **if the weekday permit is displayed**. However, these lots will be restricted from use by permit holders on game day, if the vehicle is not already parked when the monitor arrives. These lots include:

More Student Parking Information...

- S11-Manning Lot
- S11-Bowles Lot
- N5-Boundary Street
- N5-Forest Theatre

Students who must come to campus to conduct academic business, may park in the Emerson Drive or Davis Drive Lots, if space is available.

Graduate students working on experiments or having some other type of academic business may arrange parking by contacting the Parking Coordinator in their respective Graduate School Program and having the Graduate School Program Parking Coordinator contact the Event Services Division or via the special event on-line request form (<http://www.dps.unc.edu/Forms/specialevents/specialevents1.cfm>). Special Event permit quantities are limited, so Special Event Permits will only be issued to those with identification indicating their status as a graduate student (Valid PID's may be required). Special Event permits of this type are for academic business only and not for game parking. Abuse of the request process will prompt the elimination of this service.



Reserved Event Permit Parking



Certain lots are reserved for Educational Foundation and Athletic Department parking. Employees, Students and Visitors MUST relocate their vehicles from these locations by 8:00 a.m. on Home Football Saturdays.

Failure to remove vehicles from these areas by 8:00 a.m. will result in the issuance of a \$20 ticket for temporary parking restrictions and a \$90 - \$100 fee for the towing of the vehicle from the reserved lot.

Driving Directions

Kenan Stadium, home of the UNC Football Team, is located off Highway 54 and South Road along Stadium Drive on the UNC Campus. However, all parking along South Road and Stadium Drive is reserved and access to those roads requires a valid game day parking permit.

Helpful Hints: Public Parking is best accessed via US 15/501 to Columbia Street and Manning Drive. Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54. Likewise, patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to Columbia Street exit to Manning Drive, rather than entering campus along Raleigh Road or Manning Drive at US 15/501. Patrons arriving from Burlington and points south via I-85 and I-40 (traveling north and east) may find it easier to access campus via Highway 86 to Martin Luther King Boulevard then Pittsboro Street or via Highway 54 to Columbia Street.

DPS highly recommends avoiding South Road and/or Manning Drive between 15/501 and Hibbard Drive when arriving for football games. Most public parking is located off the Columbia Street corridor and Manning Drive.

Public Parking Directions

There is no public parking immediately surrounding the stadium or on the north side of campus on home football game days. However, Public Parking is available on campus in designated lots (see event map for directions).

The **Ambulatory Care Lot (Disability Parking)** can be accessed by taking 15-501 to South Columbia Street and then taking South Columbia Street to Mason Farm Road (just prior to the intersection of Manning Drive and Columbia and Pittsboro Streets) and turning right onto Mason Farm Road or from Historic Airport Road (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) to Columbia Street then turning right onto Cameron Avenue and left onto Pittsboro Street and then merging back into Columbia Street and turning left onto Mason Farm Road.

The **Cardinal Deck** can be accessed by taking 15-501 to South Columbia Street and then taking South Columbia Street to Manning Drive and turning right onto Manning Drive then turning right onto West Drive or by taking from Historic Airport Road (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) to Columbia Street then turning right onto Cameron Avenue and left onto Pittsboro Street and then merging back into Manning Drive while crossing Columbia Street and then turning right onto West Drive.

The **Jackson Deck** can be accessed by taking 15-501 to South Columbia Street and then turning right onto Manning Drive, then right onto West Drive and left onto Mason Farm Road. The deck is on the right just past the 3-way stop. From Airport Road (now Martin Luther King Jr.

Boulevard), follow it to Columbia Street then turn right onto Cameron Avenue and left onto Pittsboro Street (stay in the right lane on Pittsboro Street) and stay left to Manning Drive. Once on Manning Drive, turn right onto West Drive and left onto Mason Farm Road. The deck is on the right just past the 3-way stop.

The **General Administration Lot** can be accessed from the north by taking 15-501 South to Raleigh Road and from the east by taking Highway 54 west until it turns into Raleigh Road just past the 15-501 by-pass and from the south and west by taking 15-501 north to Raleigh Road. There is a shuttle that operates from this lot to campus as part of the parking fee.

The **Manning Lot** can be accessed from the north by taking 15-501 South to Manning Drive toward UNC Hospitals and then turning right onto Manning Drive and then turning left onto Bowles Drive. It can be located from the east by taking Highway 54 west to the 15-501 Boulevard (Fordham Boulevard) and going under the bridge and up the ramp to 15-501 and then turning right and following the boulevard to Manning Drive and turning left onto Bowles Drive. Motorists traveling from the south along 15-501 can locate it by following 15-501 north to Columbia Street and then turning right onto Manning Drive and following Manning Drive to the 7th stop light and turning right onto Bowles Drive and following Bowles Drive around past the Smith Center to the lot on the right. Motorists traveling onto campus via Airport Road from I-40 should follow Airport Road into town and stay on it as it becomes Columbia Street and then turn left onto Cameron Avenue and then left onto Pittsboro Street and then stay left onto Manning Drive (crossing Columbia) and then follow Manning Drive to the 7th stop light and turning right onto Bowles Drive and following Bowles Drive around past the Smith Center to the lot on the right.

Helpful Hint: Educational Foundation members that choose to give their parking permit to someone for a specific game should also give their guest directions on finding parking and information on suggested directions of travel. It is not uncommon for patrons to not know how to find the assigned parking location or to travel in a direction that does not allow for efficient locating of the parking destination. Consequently, lost patrons contribute to traffic congestion which leads to slower ingress and egress times pre and post game.

Smith Center Lots: The Smith Center Lots are best accessed via US 15/501 to Manning Drive and Manning Drive to Bowles Drive. Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to Highway 54 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54. Likewise, patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to Manning Drive, rather than entering campus along Raleigh Road or Franklin Street. Patrons arriving from Burlington and points south via I-85 may find it easier to access campus via Highway 54 to Manning Drive rather than attempting to arrive via I-40 to Highway 86 / Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

More Rams Club Reserved Parking Directions...

Craige Deck and Public Safety Lot: These Lots are best accessed via US 15/501 to Manning Drive and Manning Drive to Bowles Drive. Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to Highway 54 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54. Likewise, patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to Manning Drive, rather than entering campus along Raleigh Road or Franklin Street. Patrons arriving from Burlington and points south via I-85 may find it easier to access campus via Highway 54 to Manning Drive rather than attempting to arrive via I-40 to Highway 86 / Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

Hibbard Drive: This parking area is best accessed via US 15/501 to Manning Drive and Manning Drive to Hibbard Drive.

Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to Highway 54 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54. From US 15/501 and I-64 from Pittsboro, follow 15/501 to

Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to South Columbia Street is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54 to US 15/501. From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and cross the bridge rather than exiting onto US 15/501 North and NC Highway 54 East. The road becomes Columbia Street after crossing the bridge. Follow Columbia Street to the 3rd light after crossing the bridge and turn right onto Manning Drive. Once on Manning Drive, turn right at the fourth light onto Hibbard Drive.

Cardinal Deck: The **Cardinal Deck** is best accessed by taking US 15-501 to South Columbia Street and then taking South Columbia Street to Manning Drive and turning right onto Manning Drive then turning right onto West Drive.

Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to South Columbia Street is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54 to US 15/501. From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and cross the bridge rather than exiting onto US 15/501 North and NC Highway 54 East. The road becomes Columbia Street after crossing the bridge. Follow Columbia Street to the 3rd light after crossing the bridge and turn right onto Manning Drive. Once on Manning Drive, turn right at the next light onto West Drive. The Cardinal Deck has multiple entrances on the left. Make sure your parking permit is properly displayed so the parking attendant can see it or you will be charged \$10 to park.

Patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to South Columbia Street, rather than entering campus along Manning Drive or Raleigh Road. Follow US 15/501 from Durham to Columbia Street (like you are heading towards Pittsboro). At the top of the exit ramp onto US 15/501 South, turn right onto Columbia Street (at the stoplight) and go to the 2nd light and turn right onto West Drive. The Cardinal Deck has multiple entrances on the left. Make sure your parking permit is properly displayed so the parking attendant can see it or you will be charged \$10 to park.

Patrons arriving from the Burlington area may find it best to enter campus via Highway 54 to South Columbia Street or I-40 to Highway 86 to Historic Airport Road (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) to Columbia Street. From Burlington on NC Highway 54, exit onto the first UNC exit onto US 15/501 South and then turn left at the stoplight heading toward UNC Hospitals and

UNC. Cross the bridge and follow Columbia Street to the 3rd light after crossing the bridge and then turn right onto Manning Drive. Once on Manning Drive, turn right at the next light onto West Drive. The Cardinal Deck has multiple entrances on the left. Make sure your parking permit is properly displayed so the parking attendant can see it or you will be charged \$10 to park.

From NC 86 and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, merge onto Columbia Street near Rosemary and Franklin Streets and follow Columbia to Cameron Avenue. Turn right onto Cameron Avenue and then left at the next light onto Pittsboro Street. Follow Pittsboro Street past the first light and get into the left lane and stay to the left and the split. Cross Manning Drive and then turn right at the first light onto West Drive. The Cardinal Deck has multiple entrances on the left. Make sure your parking permit is properly displayed so the parking attendant can see it or you will be charged \$10 to park.

DPS does not recommend trying to reach the Cardinal Deck via the Smith Center end of Manning Drive or cutting through campus. Doing so adds to traffic congestion and makes traffic move slower.

Ehringhaus Lower Lot: The Lower Ehringhaus Lot is best accessed via US 15/501 to Manning Drive and Manning Drive to Ehringhaus and Koury Residence Halls.

Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to Highway 54 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54.

Likewise, patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to Manning Drive, rather than entering campus along Raleigh Road or Franklin Street.

Patrons arriving from Burlington and points south via I-85 may find it easier to access campus via Highway 54 to Manning Drive rather than attempting to arrive via I-40 to Highway 86 / Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

From the 15/501 end of Manning Drive, follow Manning Drive to the first drive on the right and turn right onto Ehringhaus Drive next to Koury Residence Hall. Follow the drive all of the way to the back of Ehringhaus Residence Hall and down the hill. The Lower Ehringhaus Lot is the only portion of the area available to game day Ehringhaus permit holders. DO NOT park in the upper lot. Game day permits may be towed from the upper portion of the lot because it is reserved for student permit parking only.

From the Columbia Street end of Manning Drive, follow Manning Drive past the Ridge Road intersection (past the 6th light on Manning from Columbia). Turn left onto Ehringhaus Drive next to Koury Residence Hall. Follow the drive all of the way to the back of Ehringhaus Residence Hall and down the hill. The Lower Ehringhaus Lot is the only portion of the area available to game day Ehringhaus permit holders. DO NOT park in the upper lot. Game day permits may be towed from the upper portion of the lot because it is reserved for student permit parking only.

Rams Head Deck: The Rams Head Deck is best accessed via US 15/501 to Manning Drive and Manning Drive to Ridge Road or via Manning Drive from Columbia Street.

Patrons arriving from the Raleigh Direction may find US 64 to US 15/501 to Highway 54 is a better route than utilizing I-40 to Highway 54. Likewise, patrons arriving from the Durham area on US 15/501 would be better served to stay on US 15/501 to Manning Drive, rather than entering campus along Raleigh Road or Franklin Street. Patrons arriving from Burlington and points south via I-85 may find it easier to access campus via Highway 54 to Manning Drive rather than attempting to arrive via I-40 to Highway 86 / Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

From the 15/501 end of Manning Drive, follow Manning Drive to the first stoplight. Show your Rams Head Deck permit to the Ridge Road/Manning Drive monitor and then turn right onto Ridge Road. The deck is down the hill and on the left. From the Columbia Street end of Manning Drive, follow Manning Drive past UNC Hospitals on the left. Once at the 6th stoplight at Ridge Road intersection, show your Rams Head Deck permit to the monitor and then turn left onto Ridge Road. The deck is down the hill on the left.

Ridge Road Street Permits: The Ridge Road Street parking locations are best accessed Country Club Road and Raleigh Road to Ridge Road once on campus. We do not suggest arriving via Manning Drive because most of the spaces face the opposite direction of travel. It is best to arrive from the north side of campus via Raleigh Road or Country Club Road so the vehicles face the correct direction of travel. This allows traffic to flow better pre and post game.

If arriving via US 15/501 from Durham or from Highway 54 from I-40, take the UNC exit at the Highway 54 and 15/501 bridge to Raleigh Road. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stop light and turn left onto Country Club Road and then an immediate right onto Ridge Road.

If arriving from Highway 86, follow it to Columbia Street and then turn left onto Cameron Avenue. Follow Cameron Avenue until it becomes Country Club Road and then follow it across South Road to Ridge Road and turn right.

If arriving from US 15/501 from Durham an alternate route would be to exit US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Raleigh Street (just prior to the Morehead Planetarium) and turn left onto Raleigh Street. Follow Raleigh Street to the first light and turn left onto Country Club and follow Country Club to Ridge Road (after next light) and turn right.

Navy Field and Boshamer Lots: The Navy Field and Boshamer Parking Lots are best accessed via Country Club Road and Raleigh Road to Ridge Road once on campus or via US 15/501 to Manning Drive on the Smith Center end of Manning Drive.

If arriving via US 15/501 from Durham or from Highway 54 from I-40, take the UNC exit at the Highway 54 and 15/501 bridge to Raleigh Road. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stop light and turn left onto Country Club Road and then an immediate right onto Ridge Road. If arriving from US 15/501 from Durham an alternate route would be to exit US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Raleigh Street (just prior to the Morehead Planetarium) and turn left onto Raleigh Street. Follow Raleigh Street to the first light and turn left onto Country Club and follow Country Club to Ridge Road (after the 2nd light) and turn right.

If arriving from Highway 86, follow it to Columbia Street and then turn left onto Cameron Avenue. Follow Cameron Avenue until it becomes Country Club Road and then follow it across South Road to Ridge Road and turn right.

From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and take the ramp to Highway 54 East. Follow Highway 54 East to Manning Drive and turn left onto Manning Drive. Follow Manning Drive to the first stoplight. Show your Navy Field or Boshamer Lot permits to the Ridge Road/Manning Drive monitor and then turn right onto Ridge Road. Navy Field Lot will be on the left after Stadium Drive and Boshamer will be on the right.

Cobb Deck Permits: The Cobb Deck is best accessed via Country Club Road or Raleigh Street.

If arriving via US 15/501 from Durham or from Highway 54 from I-40, take the UNC exit at the Highway 54 and 15/501 bridge to Raleigh Road. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stop light and turn right onto Country Club Road and then turn right at the next stoplight onto PGT Drive (Gimghoul Road on right). If arriving from US 15/501 from Durham an alternate route would be to exit US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Raleigh Street (just prior to the Morehead Planetarium) and turn left onto Raleigh Street. Follow Raleigh Street to the first light and turn left onto Country Club and follow Country Club to to the next stoplight and turn right.

If arriving via Highway 86, follow it to Columbia Street and then turn left onto Cameron Avenue. Follow Cameron Avenue until it becomes Country Club Road and then follow it to the next stoplight and turn right.

From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and take the ramp to Highway 54 East. Follow Highway 54 East to 2nd UNC Exit (cross the NC 54 bridge and turn right onto the down ramp and go under the bridge to Raleigh Road). Follow Raleigh Road to the first stoplight and turn right onto Country Club Road and then turn left at the next stoplight onto PGT Drive (Gimghoul Road on right).

Stadium Drive Permits: Stadium Drive is best accessed via South Road.

If arriving via NC Highway 54 from I-40, follow NC 54 to the US 15/501 and stay straight under the bridge onto Raleigh Road. Do NOT exit onto NC 54 or US 15/501 at the US 15/501 bridge. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stoplight and cross Country Club Road. Keep going past the next stoplight and then turn left at the next drive on the left. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving via US 15/501 from Durham, there are two routes. Route 1: Exit off of US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Raleigh Street (just prior to the Morehead Planetarium) and turn left onto Raleigh Street. Follow Raleigh Street to the second stoplight and turn right onto South Road and then turn left at the next drive which will be Stadium Drive. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit. Route 2: Follow US 15/501 to the first UNC exit and turn right down the exit. Follow Raleigh Road to to the first stoplight and cross Country Club Road. Keep going past the next stoplight and then turn left at the next drive on the left. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving from Highway 86, follow it to Columbia Street and then turn right onto Cameron Avenue and then left at the next stoplight onto Pittsboro Street. Follow Pittsboro Street to the

next stoplight and turn left onto McCauley Street and cross Columbia Street to South Road. Be prepared to show the monitor at South Road your permit since South Road is restricted at Columbia Street. Once on South Road, go past the two stoplights and past the Bell Tower to the next drive and turn right onto Stadium Drive (again be prepared to show your permit).

From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and cross the bridge rather than exiting onto US 15/501 North and NC Highway 54 East. The road becomes Columbia Street after crossing the bridge. Follow Columbia Street to South Road (5th light after crossing the bridge) and show your Stadium Drive permit to the monitor at Columbia/South Road. Turn right onto South Road and follow it to the first drive past the Bell Tower (again be prepared to show your permit).

McCauley Deck Permits: McCauley Deck is accessed via McCauley Street from either Pittsboro Street or Columbia Street.

If arriving via NC Highway 54 from I-40, follow NC 54 to the US 15/501 and stay straight under the bridge onto Raleigh Road. Do NOT exit onto NC 54 or US 15/501 at the US 15/501 bridge. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stoplight and turn right onto Country Club Road. Follow Country Club Road to Raleigh Road and cross it onto Cameron Avenue. Follow Cameron Avenue to Pittsboro Street and turn left onto Pittsboro Street. Once on Pittsboro Street, follow it to the first stoplight and turn left onto McCauley Street and then turn right into the first drive on the right. The deck is on the right underneath the FedEx Global Education Building. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving via US 15/501 from Durham, there are two routes. Route 1: Exit off of US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Columbia Street and turn left onto Columbia Street. Follow Columbia Street to Cameron Avenue and turn right onto Cameron Avenue. Once on Cameron follow it one light to Pittsboro Street and turn left. Once on Pittsboro Street, follow it to the first stoplight and turn left onto McCauley Street and then turn right into the first drive on the right. The deck is on the right underneath the FedEx Global Education Building. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving from Highway 86, follow it to Columbia Street and then turn right onto Cameron Avenue and then left at the next stoplight onto Pittsboro Street. Follow Pittsboro Street to the next stoplight and turn left onto McCauley Street and then turn right into the first drive on the right. The deck is on the right underneath the FedEx Global Education Building. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and cross the bridge rather than exiting onto US 15/501 North and NC Highway 54 East. The road becomes Columbia Street after crossing the bridge. Follow Columbia Street to the South Road (on right) and McCauley Deck intersection and turn left onto McCauley Street and then immediately left onto the next drive on the left. The deck is on the right underneath the FedEx Global Education Building. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

Nash Lot Permits: Nash Lot is accessed via Wilson Street from Cameron Avenue.

If arriving via NC Highway 54 from I-40, follow NC 54 to the US 15/501 and stay straight under the bridge onto Raleigh Road. Do NOT exit onto NC 54 or US 15/501 at the US 15/501 bridge. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stoplight and turn right onto Country Club Road. Follow Country Club Road to Raleigh Road and cross it onto Cameron Avenue. Follow Cameron Avenue past Pittsboro Street to the next street on the left and turn left onto Wilson Street. The Nash Lot is at the end of Wilson Street and on the right. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving via US 15/501 from Durham, exit off of US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Columbia Street and turn left onto Columbia Street. Follow Columbia Street to Cameron Avenue and turn right onto Cameron Avenue. Once on Cameron follow it past the Pittsboro Street light and turn left at the first street onto Wilson Street. The Nash Lot is at the end of Wilson Street and on the right. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving from Highway 86, follow it to Columbia Street and then turn right onto Cameron Avenue. Once on Cameron follow it past the Pittsboro Street light and turn left at the first street onto Wilson Street. The Nash Lot is at the end of Wilson Street and on the right. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and cross the bridge rather than exiting onto US 15/501 North and NC Highway 54 East. The road becomes Columbia Street after crossing the bridge. Follow Columbia Street to the Cameron Avenue and turn left. Once on Cameron follow it past the Pittsboro Street light and and turn left at the first street onto Wilson Street. The Nash Lot is at the end of Wilson Street and on the right. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

Park Place Permits: Park Place is accessed via Franklin Street to Boundary Street or via Boundary Street from Country Club Road.

If arriving via NC Highway 54 from I-40, follow NC 54 to the US 15/501 and stay straight under the bridge onto Raleigh Road. Do NOT exit onto NC 54 or US 15/501 at the US 15/501 bridge. Follow Raleigh Road to the first stoplight and turn right onto Country Club Road. Follow Country Club Road past the first stoplight and turn right at the first road on the right onto Boundary Street (next to the Forest Theatre). Follow Boundary Street around past Park Place Street and the parking lot is on the right. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving via US 15/501, exit off of US 15/501 onto East Franklin Street and follow Franklin Street to Boundary Street (2 street prior to the Morehead Planetarium). Turn left onto Boundary Street from Franklin Street and the lot is immediately on the left. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

If arriving from Highway 86, follow it to Franklin Street and then turn left onto Franklin Street. Follow Franklin Street the second street past the Morehead Planetarium and turn right onto

Boundary Street. The Park Place Lot is on the left. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

From US 64 / Pittsboro, follow US 15/501 to NC Highway 54 and cross the bridge rather than exiting onto US 15/501 North and NC Highway 54 East. The road becomes Columbia Street after crossing the bridge. Follow Columbia Street to Cameron Avenue and turn right. Follow Cameron Avenue until it crosses Raleigh Street and becomes Country Club Road and then turn left off of Country Club onto Boundary Street (at the intersection of Boundary, Battle Lane and Country Club). Follow Boundary Street around past Park Place Street and the parking lot is on the right. Be prepared to show the parking attendant your parking permit.

Note: The Department of Public Safety does not assign Educational Foundation parking permits. Educational Foundation permits are assigned by the Educational Foundation via an approved point system. Likewise, the Department of Public Safety does not re-issue lost or stolen permits. Educational Foundation permits are not for re-sale or duplication and may be confiscated or revoked if sold or distributed against policy.
