Reserved Parking Information

There are two parking areas reserved on baseball game days. Both areas require a specific valid game day permit.

Boshamer Lot- Is reserved primarily for weekday academic permit holders until 5 p.m. on weekdays. For this reason, there is a very limited number of game day weekday permits issued and allowed into the lot prior to 5 p.m. For weekend games, a larger number of game day permits are issued and the entire lot is reserved for game day permit holders.

Avery Lot- This lot is reserved for game day operations and is thus closed to everyone but game day operations staff with the appropriate credentials for both weekday and weekend games.

Note: Campus parking lots are restricted Monday thru Friday until either 5 p.m. or 9 p.m. For this reason, fans should park in the visitor pay lots if arriving for games prior to 5 p.m. After 5 p.m., fans should check the lot entrance signs to ensure the lot is open. Some lots such as the Ehringhaus Lot are reserved until 9 p.m. on weeknights and consequently require a valid weekday permit. Parking Regulations remain in effect on campus at all times, with few exceptions. Parking without a valid permit in a restricted permit lot, will likely result in a parking citation.

General Public Parking Information

Although some of the lots near Boshamer are reserved for valid game permit holders and/or normal weekday permit holders, fans attending baseball games have several parking options depending on the day of the week and the time of the game.

Weekday Games Prior to 5 p.m.

There are generally two parking options available:

- **Highway 54 Lot**-Easy walking distance down Ridge Road from Country Club and South Road
- **Rams Head Parking Deck**- Easy walking distance along Ridge Road and within sight of Boshamer Stadium. Parking is generally \$5 per game or \$1.50 per hour depending on arrival time.

Weekday Games After 5 p.m.

Most lots become open to the public on a first-come-first serve basis after 5 p.m. However, some lots are restricted until 9 p.m. Motorists should check the lot entrance signs to be sure of the restrictions before parking. The following locations are available after 5 p.m. and are suggested parking locations.

- **Stadium Drive**-Easy walking distance up Ridge Road, but fills rapidly, so space is not always easy to find.
- **Navy Field Lot**- Across the street from Boshamer, but sometimes restricted for other events.
- **School of Government Deck**- Positioned near the intramural fields on South Road, but easy walking distance, if one walks towards the Law School and Ridge Road. The deck is sometimes reserved for other functions.
- **Bowles Lot**- A little further walk than the other mentioned locations, but almost always available after 5 p.m. The exceptions generally occur during men's basketball season when the lot is reserved for basketball.

Additionally, the [Rams Head Parking Deck](#) on Ridge Road and the [Highway 54 Lot](#) on Raleigh Road almost always have available parking. Beginning as early as 2 hours prior to game time, until approximately 30-minutes after the first pitch, baseball

parking will be available first-come-first serve for \$5 upon entry (entry stub valid until approximately 45-minutes after the end of the game). Fans arriving prior to or after game operations will incur a \$1.50 per hour parking fee, if choosing to park in available spaces in the Rams Head Deck. There will generally be no charge after 5 p.m. for fans choosing to park in the Highway 54 Lot after game operations cease (approximately 30-minutes after first pitch).

Weekend Games

As is true for weekdays after 5 p.m., most lots are open to the public on a first-come-first serve basis. However, parking is still not allowed outside of marked spaces such as travel lanes, fire lanes, or landscaping or sidewalks. Parking is also not allowed in marked reserved spaces unless the vehicle is displaying a valid parking permit. Parking restrictions are enforced and violators can be ticketed and / or towed.

Unless otherwise reserved, suggested parking locations include:

- Stadium Drive
- Navy Field Lot
- School of Government Deck
- Bowles Lot
- Ehringhaus Lot

Directions

Of all the locations, the **Highway 54 Lot** is the easiest and quickest to locate, but also is often the first to reach capacity. It can be found by entering campus via Highway 54 or US 15/501 and entering campus on Raleigh Road. Once you're off the by-pass or under the by-pass, follow Raleigh Road up the hill toward campus. The Highway 54 Lot is on the right just prior to the 1st stoplight.

Stadium Drive is situated between **South Road and Ridge Road** and can be accessed from both South Road and Ridge Road. Although it opens to public parking after 5 p.m. on weeknights and most weekends, it is usually in high demand by campus students and parking can be difficult to find in that area. If you can locate parking along Stadium Drive, the walk is easy. [Follow Stadium Drive to Ridge Road and turn left. Boshamer Stadium is to the left and within sight of the intersection.](#)

The **School of Government Deck** is located on **South Road** next to the Knapp-Sanders School of Government and the intramural fields. From the roadway, it does not resemble a parking deck because the top of it is "on grade" with South

Road and the School of Government. However, there is actually a level of parking below South Road and level with the athletic fields. To access Boshamer, exit the deck on the end closest to the Law School and away from South Road and walk thru the Law School Lot toward Ridge Road and you can locate Boshamer Stadium along Ridge Road in that direction. The walk takes an average person about 5-6 minutes.

The Navy Field Lot is located on Ridge Road. From Raleigh Road, turn left onto Country Club and then right onto Ridge Road. The Navy Field Lot is on the right after the Law School and just prior to and in sight of Boshamer Stadium.

The Rams Head Deck is located on Ridge Road and within sight of the Stadium. Ridge Road can be accessed from either Country Club Road or Manning Drive. From US 15/501, turn onto Manning Drive and then turn right at the first stoplight. Rams Head Deck is down the hill on the left across from the turf field. From Highway 54, take South Road to Country Club Road and turn left onto Country Club Road, then turn right onto Ridge Road. Follow Ridge Road past the baseball stadium to the large brick building on the right just past Stadium Drive and across from the turf field (Ehringhaus Field).

Bowles Lot is located off Manning Drive next to the Dean E. Smith Center. With the exception of men's basketball game dates and other rare Smith Center events, the lot is almost never full after 5 p.m. and on weekends. Fans choosing to use this location, should access it from 15/501 to Manning Drive, and then turn left onto Bowles Drive at the 1st stoplight on Manning Drive. Bowles Lot is on the right. By following these directions, fans will avoid traffic congestion on Raleigh Road, South Road and Ridge Road. The walk to Boshamer takes an average person about 8-9 minutes because part of the walk to the stadium is up hill. However, it is much easier to exit the lot post game, than to exit the Rams Head Parking Deck when it is near or at capacity.

Ehringhaus Lot is located off Manning Drive next to Ehringhaus Residence Hall. The lot is comprised of two areas. One on grade with and near Manning Drive and at the rear of and slightly down the hill from Ehringhaus Residence Hall. To access Boshamer Stadium from Ehringhaus Residence Hall, fans can walk thru the front on-grade parking lot to the rear lot and toward the stadium Boshamer Stadium actually borders the back of the lower rear parking lot. **NOTE:** Spaces along the baseball outfield fence are sometimes blocked for TV operations and baseballs do sometimes clear the fence / netting of the field and "hit" parked vehicles. Parking in the lot is a personal decision and any damages or injuries sustained are not the responsibility of the University.



Disability Parking Information



Disability Parking and disability golf cart shuttles will be available for each home game from the [Rams Head Parking Deck](#) along Ridge Road.

Golf Carts operated by the UNC Department of Public Safety and sponsored by the UNC Department of Athletics will operate to/from the main entrance of the Rams Head Deck to/from Boshamer Stadium beginning 90 minutes prior to game time, throughout each game and up to approximately 30 minutes following each game for all regular home baseball games.

[There is no charge to ride the shuttles and drivers cannot accept gratuities. However, there is a charge for parking in the Rams Head Parking Deck.](#)

Beginning as early as 2 hours prior to game time, until approximately 30 minutes after the first pitch, baseball parking is available in the [Rams Head Deck](#), first-come-first serve, for \$5 upon entry (entry stub valid until approximately 45 minutes after the end of the game). Fans arriving prior to or after game operations will incur a \$1.50 per hour parking fee, if choosing to park in available spaces in the Rams Head Deck. There will generally be no charge after 5 p.m. for fans choosing to park in the Highway 54 Lot after game operations cease (approximately 30 minutes after first pitch).

Charter Bus Parking

Due to the increase in ticket sales, construction on campus and conflicting events, bus parking on campus cannot be guaranteed. Groups planning on arriving in buses should make prior arrangements for parking at least 72 hours prior to game date. Arrangements can be made by contacting the Department of Public Safety at 962-3951 or via the special event request forms on-line at

The Department of Public Safety will do their best to provide buses with parking. In most cases, buses will be asked to park at the Dean E. Smith Center. However, there may be occasions when there are conflicting events on campus and extra buses cannot be accommodated. It is best to contact the Department of Public Safety at least 72 hours in advance of a game date, to be sure bus parking is available.

Media Parking

Reserved media parking is available by contacting UNC Sports Information in advance or on an "as available" basis on game day by contacting the monitor at the entrance to Boshamer Drive. Generally speaking, media parking will likely be available in the Rams Head Parking Deck off Ridge Road.

There will be no media parking in the Boshamer parking lot.
